## Abstracts submission

- An abstract with maximum length of 1 page should be typewritten with 1.25 line of space. The typing margins of top, bottom, left and right are all 3 cm.
- The Abstract must be arranged in the following order: Title, Name(s) and Address(es), Abstract and References.
- Title and Authors: The title should be in first capital letter, Arial 12 pt, bold and centered. It should be followed by 1 line of space, then by the author names, and followed by 1 line of space, and by address. Name and address of authors should be in Times New Roman 11 pt, and centered, and address should be in italics. The name of the presenting author should be underlined.
- Text: The text should be in Times New Roman 11 pt, and justified.
- References: References should be indicated within the text and appear at the end of the abstract . Each reference should be in Times New Roman 11, justified and numbered consecutively.
